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OBSBA PARENT PARTICIPATION

• CAR WASH #1:

– This involves every player and several parents to be there for the duration of the car wash (11-3). Parents are needed to ensure players are cleaning cars, behaving and working hard. Parents also collect the funds, order pizza for the boys and do quality control on the cars washed.

Shifts for parents- 11:00am -3:00pm

Needed: Donut donations and water bottles, Pizza for after car wash

- WEBSITE: maintain website including emails, game schedule, forms, directions to games
- **SENIOR NIGHT Coordinators:** This is a several person job and includes the players. It ideally should not be done by a senior parent. We have template for most things including the bios, program booklet and posters. The tasks include:
 - o Getting pictures of each senior player and making them into posters and hanging that night early
 - Getting bios of each senior player and making into a program with pictures
 - Buying and bringing balloons for the event and arriving early
 - Buying flowers to give to senior parents at half time
 - Arranging for announcer (Mr Ehman?) to come for half time presentation. Inviting principals and Athletic Directors as well
- **SNACK bags:** Bring drink and fruit for half time at all games.
- Concession Table Help: Staff table at home games
- **BANQUET:** This is a several person job and includes the following tasks:
 - securing a date and location
 - arranging with and setting price for non-players
 - o creating a flyer/ registration form and collecting money
 - o getting supplies including paper products, table cloths etc for event
 - o ordering, picking up and bringing sheet cake
 - inviting principals and AD's
 - working with senior boys to do paper plate awards and talk
 - o arranging for coaches gift with senior players
- **COMMUNITY SERVICE:** Organizes a community service event for the team, typically after the end of the season at an east end location
- GATE FEE COLLECTION FOR HOME GAMES: Arrive about 20 minutes before the game with the money box and tickets. You stay at the entrance to collect the entrance fee until half time. Turn in money to one of the booster members to deposit. Generally one parent, although can also be staffed by parent selling 50/50
- Schedule (8 home games for collection)
- **50/50:** Sell tickets before game, and through first half. Drawing will be completed during Half time. Generally chose a child from opposing team to draw ticket.
